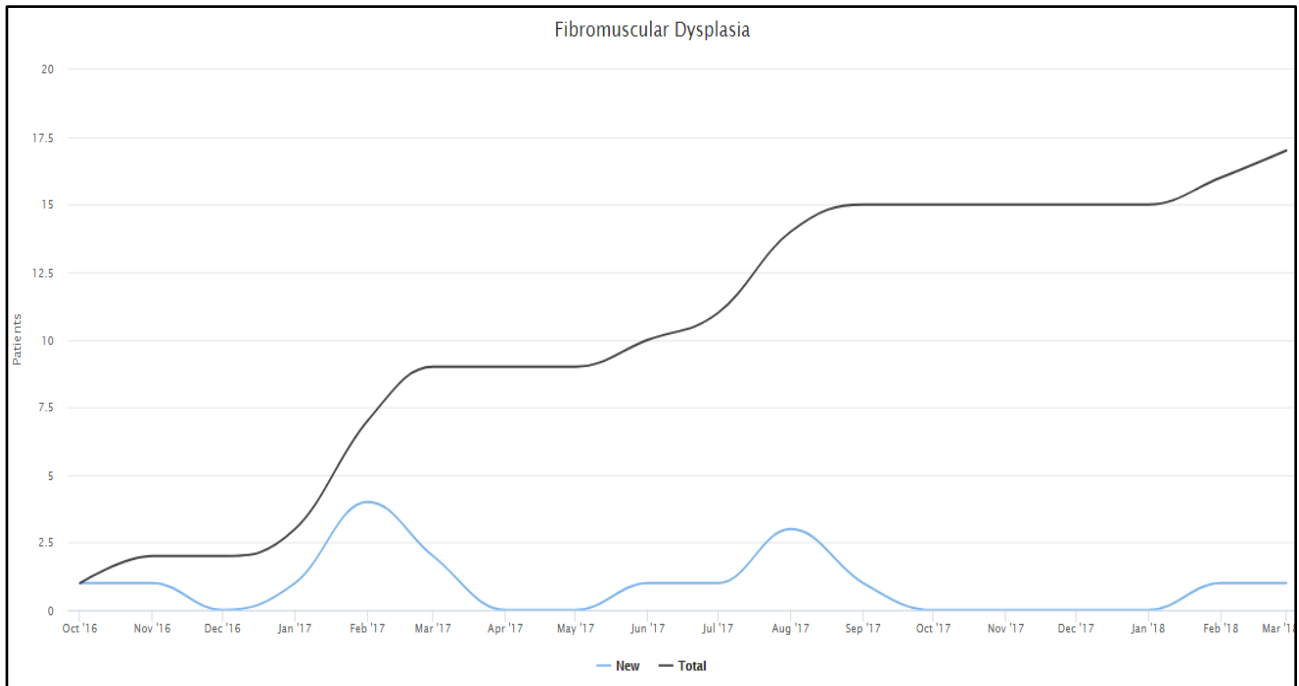

Summary of RDG Activity (Meetings, patient events, grants, research studies, conference papers etc)	<p>The last two years has seen a number of publications from established FMD groups in Europe and America showing FMD occurs in multiple arterial beds in 50 % of cases. As such, the entry criteria to RaDaR FMD indicate that entry can include FMD in any arterial bed to hopefully encourage more patients to be uploaded. In addition, we have increased the number of clinicians from varying disciplines on our conference calls which occur every 2 months.</p> <p>Dr Chrysochou has used two presentations at the national cardio Renal forum (October 2017, London) and international FMD Symposium (February 2018, Brussels) as opportunities to encourage uploading of patients to RaDaR FMD.</p> <p>Dr Chrysochou has built ties with Patient representatives who have built an FMD Facebook group for Britain and Ireland. 45 patients are currently in the group. It is hoped that this will also indirectly help patient recruitment to RaDaR. Discussions are underway about running a Patient event in the next year.</p>
